The head coach must provide excellent coaching, leadership, communication, and organizational skills. Duties entail, but are not limited to:

- Hiring, training, supervising, and evaluating assistant coaches
- Participating in pre-season planning
- Developing swim practices that balance both stroke work and endurance
- Coaching all morning and afternoon practices
- Overseeing the pre-team swim program
- Communicating consistently and diplomatically with swim team members, parents, and Team Reps
- Providing a positive practice environment and incentives for swimmers to swim their best
- Creating and posting meet line-ups for all meets
- Attending team social activities and contributing to the spirit associated with summer swimming
- Attending MCSL meetings, Division meetings, and pre-season meetings when requested

There is the opportunity for the Head Coach to run an early morning Masters swim program for adults (M, W, F) and receive additional compensation.

Prior swim team head coaching experience and competitive swim experience required. Knowledge of USS Swimming and Diving Rules and MCSL conference rules and regulations required. Certification in safety training for swim coaches (or equivalent) is required, as well as a pool operators license. Bachelor's degree in physical education, recreation, education (10 month teachers are encouraged to apply!) or related field is a plus.
