



Head Swim Team Coach

The Seven Locks Swim Team seeks to fill the position of Head Swim Team Coach for the 2022 season. The Seven Locks Sharks have a long and competitive history in the MCSL and currently have many strong, young swimmers rising in the ranks. The Team seeks an experienced coach excited to work with swimmers of all ages and abilities and who fosters both competitive swimming and strong team spirit and camaraderie. The team includes approximately 150 swimmers and will compete in Division G in 2022.

Head Coach Requirements:

- Previous head or assistant coaching experience with a college degree preferred (or extensive year-round club swimming and coaching experience)
- Previous competitive swimming experience (NCAA swimming experience preferred)
- Familiarity with the rules and procedures of the MCSL and USA Swimming rules and guidelines
- Ability to correctly demonstrate and teach all four strokes, turns, and starts
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, organization and management skills, and the ability to work in a positive and supportive manner with children of all ages and ability levels, as well as with their parents and leaders of the club
- Up to date Lifeguard, AED, CPR, and First Aid Certifications required (prefer Pool Operators License, but not mandatory)
- Proficiency and prior experience with the use of swim team automation software (e.g., Hy-Tek Meet Manager, Team Unify, etc.)

Head Coach Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plan for and attend all practices and meets (Saturday A-meets and Wednesday B-Meets)
- Work with assistant coach(es) to facilitate practices and formulate drills
- With the help of swim team software develop, generate, and post weekly line-ups for A and B meets in conjunction with Assistant Coach(es)
- Attend and participate in all team spirit functions, team events, pep rallies, banquets, etc.
- Lead and manage team at weekly A and B Dual Meets, Relay Carnival, Divisionals, All Stars, and MCSL Coaches Long Course
- Provide supportive and constructive feedback to all swimmers at meets and practices
- Provide information and feedback to parents and team representatives regarding swimmer needs and/or concerns that may arise
- Provide direction, mentoring, and positive leadership to coaching staff at all levels (Assistant Coaches, Junior Coaches and CITs). Lead with respect and by example.
- Encourage and support team spirit, especially at all Saturday Dual Meets and Divisional Meets. Create child appropriate and fun themes, decorate for home meets, and dress up (the sillier the better!)
