

Assistant Coach

The **Whetstone Whales** are looking for two **Assistant Coaches** for the 2012 swim season. The positions require:

- the ability to teach technical stroke techniques
- current lifeguard and CPR certifications and a valid pool operator's license (can be acquired after hiring, before the start of the season)

The ideal candidate for the Assistant Coach position will have swimming and coaching/teaching experience (paid or unpaid). However, lack of coaching experience can be overcome by superior swimming knowledge, organizational skills, demonstrated leadership skills, and enthusiasm.

We have afternoon practices from Memorial Day through the last day of school. Once school is out, we have both morning and afternoon practices. Our coaches are also expected to participate in our pep rallies, ribbon celebrations, awards banquet, 4th of July parade, and other team social events throughout the season.

We feel strongly that our coaches should focus on coaching, so the parent team reps handle all administrative tasks except preparing meet lineups.
